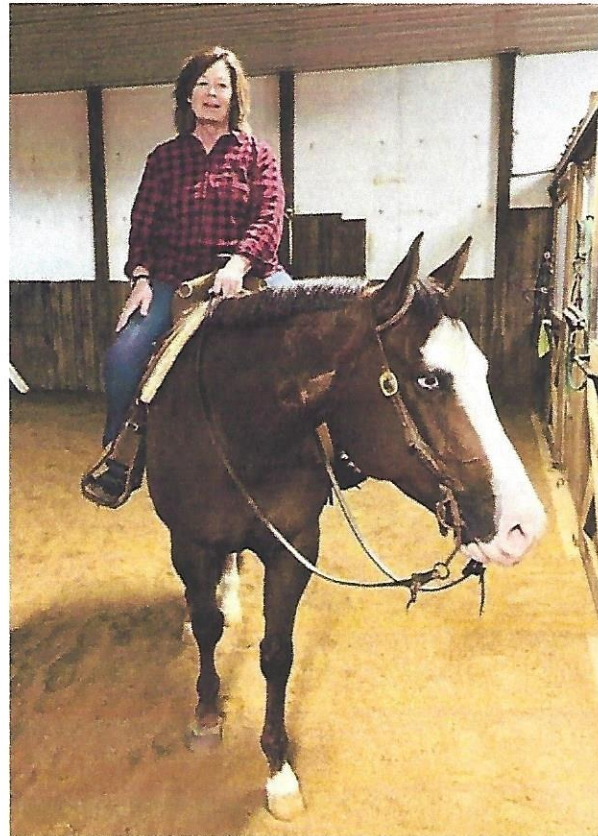

- Memorial Day was declared a National holiday in 1971.
