Barn stalls are pressure washed.

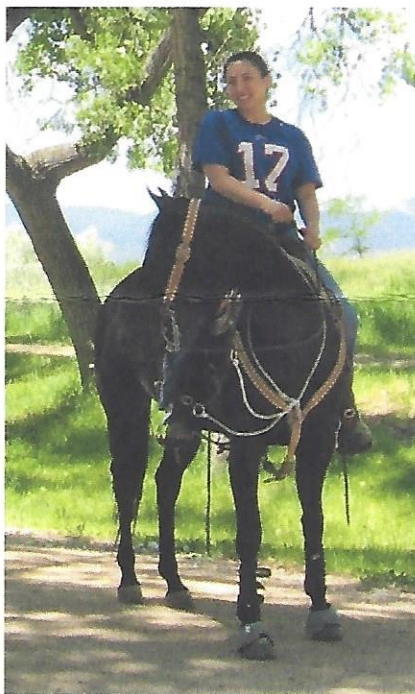
